

SunSystems 5.4 enhancements

New features of SunSystems 5.4

Compatibility and support: Windows Vista Clients and Windows Server 2008 – also 64-bit operating systems support, MS SQL 2008, Oracle 11g.

Improved user interface: tabbed sessions, flattened menu structure, free text search of functions list.

Added Security Functionality: improved permissions reporting covering forms, functions and actions, super user functions can now be assigned to regular users – improving segregation of duties and access.

Reporting Improvements: Upgraded Actuate 8 for report design, new utility to migrate reports from earlier versions.

New Business Unit Setup function: consolidates previous business unit setup functions into one streamline process.

Financials

Improvements to multi-currency: Payments and receipts can now use a current exchange rate when processing, with the system automatically calculating forex losses/gains and posting the relevant transactions. Also improved multi-currency functionality for Corporate Allocation and Financials modules, including ability to change exchange rates on a held journal once recalled, upon a period or transaction date change.

Analysis: The address table can now be used as an analysis dimension. Analysis tables can now be linked to multiple analysis dimensions.

Journal Types: Can now be suspended or closed. Unique references for journal types can now be further refined by Account Type.

Balancing: For clients that balance by transaction reference, a warning message is now issued if amendments are about to be made that will result in an unbalanced transaction.

Payments: Transactions can be selected for a particular payment set. They will then be excluded from all other payment runs and refined before being transferred to a particular payment process.

Addresses: Address records now have data access group functionality, enabling sensitive addresses to be accessed only by specific user groups.

Asset Management: Asset classes have been introduced to help grouping assets for processing through various system functions. Default depreciation rules can be set against each class, automatically assigning to new items that are posted into each class. New Asset quantities functionality allows automatic calculations of a part disposal.

Order Fulfilment: Data can now be transferred to the ledger additional fields in financials via the ledger interface.

SunSystems Connect: New option for saving input, output or both payloads after processing. Java development toolkit updated to 1.5.

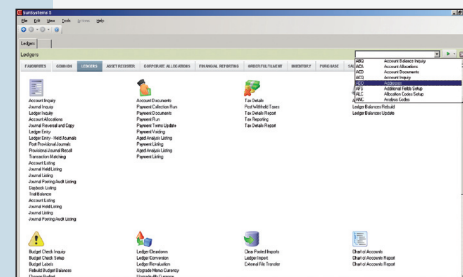
